Insurance	We, as Anadolu University do not require any special insurance other than students have. We have our own hospital (Mavi Hastane) in the campus where all incoming students can get all kind of polyclinic services free of charge. On the other hand, it is strongly advised to have at least a health insurance before coming, just in case they need it for an operation or staying in hospital.
Before & After Arrival	Please visit www.uib.anadolu.edu.tr and go to “Incoming Students” in order to find out all the necessary procedures that students should follow before and after arrival such as photos, copy of passport, health insurance information, financial statements etc.
Student pick-up	As long as the students inform their buddy student and us about their exact arrival date and time to Istanbul or Ankara, we give them advise about transportation to Eskişehir. Then buddy student can pick them up from the train station or bus station in Eskişehir. There is no cost for that. But if they come without informing us, it is possible to find the necessary information on our web site www.uib.anadolu.edu.tr →Incoming Students →Coming to Eskişehirs.
