OUR COURSES

COURSE IN PRE-FOUNDATION STUDIES (CPFS)

The Course in Pre-Foundation Studies (CPFS) at WIUT prepares students for the University by strengthening their English and math skills for the Certificate of International Foundation Studies (CIFS). It builds confidence, independence, and academic readiness for higher education. The CPFS includes two core modules:

- English: Basics of English for Academic Purposes (BEAP)
- Mathematics: Basics of Quantitative Skills (BaQS)

Aligned with the Cambridge IGCSE framework, it uses Cambridge textbooks. Students can also take the Cambridge qualification exam at Level 2, earning a lifelong certificate.

The CPFS is structured into two levels:

- Level 1: Two years (Part-time) – Students from 9th and 10th grades will be accepted and must meet the entry requirements.
- Level 2: One year (Part-time) – Students must be in the 11th grade or graduates of secondary school and must meet the entry requirements.

Entry Requirements

General Requirements:

- Applicants must have completed 8 years of Secondary Education or an equivalent qualification.
- Level 1: Students from 9th and 10th grades will be accepted.

- Level 2: Students must be in the 11th grade or graduates of secondary school.
- Students from 9th and 10th grades with outstanding IELTS and SAT results will undergo further interviews to determine their eligibility for Level 2 enrollment.

English Language Requirements:

- **Level 1:**

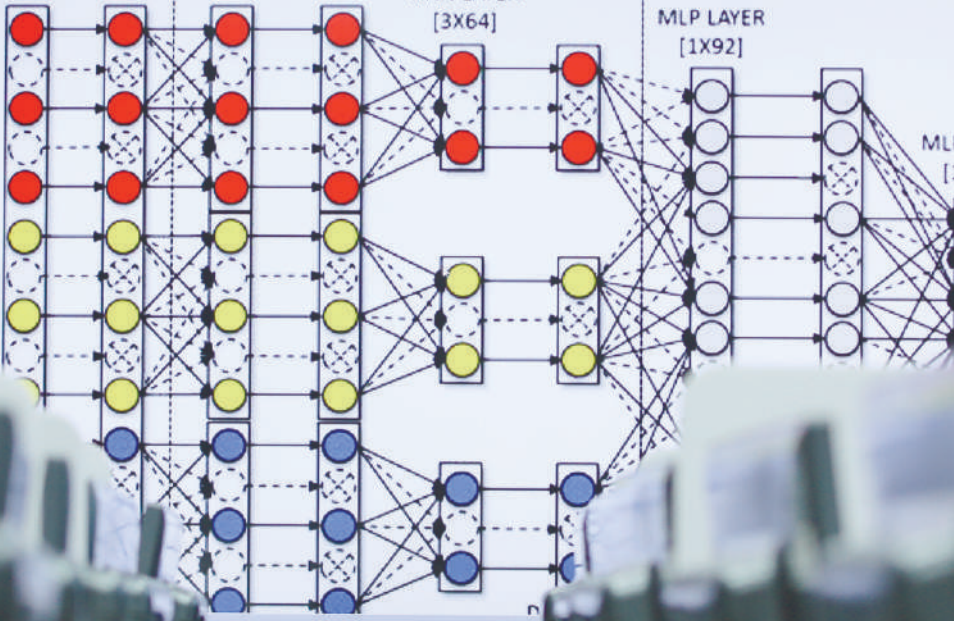

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MA in INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS MANAGEMENT

The MA in International Business Management course prepares students to become business ambassadors and future leaders. It provides knowledge and skills to tackle business, entrepreneurship, creative cultural tourism, and innovation challenges in Uzbekistan and beyond.

Students can choose from three pathways:

- MA in International Business Management
- MA in International Business Management (Creative Cultural Tourism)
- MA in International Business Management (Entrepreneurship and Innovation)

The course fosters critical and reflexive thinking, helping students progress into advanced business practitioners with a broad global perspective. Students will also engage in research projects and dissertations, gaining specialised expertise through option modules.

Key Learning Outcomes

- Gain a comprehensive understanding of international business practices.
- Develop critical thinking and strategic decision-making skills.
- Explore entrepreneurship, innovation, and creative cultural tourism in business growth.
- Apply strategic management concepts to real-world business challenges.
- Conduct research-based projects and dissertations on business topics.

Learning Methods

The course combines theoretical learning with practical applications, using:

- Lectures, seminars, and tutorials led by industry experts.
- Independent study, including research, reading, and project work.
- Case studies and practical workshops to apply theories to real-world scenarios.
- Group/team assignments to develop collaboration and leadership skills.
- Student presentations and industry-led discussions.

Course Structure

Students complete 180 credits through core and optional modules. The course structure is validated by the University of Westminster (UK) every five years and may be updated based on feedback. The course is available full-time and part-time, with the dissertation/project taking place in the summer after modules are completed.

Job opportunities

The course has an international emphasis; students tend to pursue careers in multinational companies after graduation. The course places great emphasis on the study of business management in international and local contexts, and students may specialise in either tourism or entrepreneurship and innovation. The graduates of the course may pursue leading positions in a variety of functions such as accounting, marketing, finance, economics, information technology, digital marketing, and human resource management.

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MA in LEARNING AND TEACHING

The MA in Learning and Teaching prepares future educators and leaders to address modern teaching challenges in Uzbekistan and beyond. The course focuses on learner-centred and technology-enhanced approaches, integrating pedagogical theories with practical applications to improve teaching quality. It promotes self-reflection, lifelong learning, and professional development, fostering a community of educators and researchers.

Key Learning Outcomes

- Develop expertise in learner-centered and technology-enhanced teaching.
- Strengthen critical reflection and self-assessment skills.
- Apply pedagogical theories in real-world classroom settings.
- Conduct action-based research to improve teaching practices.
- Engage in collaborative learning and professional networking.
- Foster learner autonomy and lifelong learning strategies.

Learning Methods

The course builds on students' current teaching practice, emphasising critical reflection and professional development. Learning methods include:

- Tutor, peer, and group observations on a fortnightly basis.
- Hands-on tasks and inquiry projects in the classroom.
- Micro-teaching to refine instructional strategies.

- Co-teaching to encourage collaboration and feedback.
- Blended learning tasks to enhance diverse learning experiences.
- Mentoring, coaching, and facilitation through research and reflective practice.

Course Structure

The MA in Learning and Teaching offers three pathways:

- MA in Learning and Teaching
- MA in Learning and Teaching with Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages
- MA in Learning and Teaching English for Specific Purposes

The TESOL pathway is designed for professionals specialising in Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages. It provides specialised skills and knowledge to support English language learners in diverse settings. Graduates of this pathway receive a diploma indicating their TESOL specialisation, recognising their expertise in this field.

While the course structure varies based on the chosen pathway, some core modules are compulsory for all students.

Job opportunities

With this degree, graduates are not just teachers — they are mentors, leaders, curriculum innovators, and education specialists shaping the future of learning. Beyond teaching, many graduates step into leadership roles. As a school administrator, principal, or academic advisor, you can influence educational policies and create an environment where both students and teachers thrive.

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MSc in PUBLIC HEALTH SCIENCE

The MSc in Public Health Science equips students with the skills to analyse and address public health challenges at national and global levels. The programme provides training in epidemiology, health economics, research methods, statistics, international ethics, and social sciences, preparing students for careers in public health, medicine, and related fields. It is offered in one-year full-time or two-year part-time formats, with evening classes to accommodate professionals.

Key Learning Outcomes

- Develop expertise in public health policy, epidemiology, and health economics.
- Gain research and statistical skills to analyse health data.
- Understand global and national health systems and their challenges.
- Apply behavioural and social science approaches to public health.
- Strengthen critical thinking and problem-solving skills for public health issues.
- Conduct independent research in public health and related fields.

Learning Methods

Students engage in scheduled activities and independent learning, including:

- Lectures, seminars, and tutorials with expert faculty.
- Structured independent study, including research and assignments.
- A 12,000-word dissertation demonstrating research expertise.

Classes start at 18:30, ensuring accessibility for working professionals.

Course Structure

The MSc in Public Health Science consists of core and optional modules, with students required to complete at least 180 credits. The course structure is validated by the University of Westminster (UK) every five years and may be revised based on feedback.

Job opportunities

Graduates of the course will become effective public health professionals as practitioners, clinicians, faculty in academia, managers or leaders in the public health, health care and research sectors. Graduates of the course may pursue careers in management of the public health and healthcare sector, policy analysis, monitoring, planning, evaluation and implementation of public health programmes. They may also engage with global health research through national and international government agencies, NGOs, the private sector and academic institutions.

MSc in RESEARCH METHODS FOR SOCIAL SCIENCES

The MSc in Research Methods for Social Sciences is a first-of-its-kind programme in Uzbekistan, designed to develop advanced research skills based on international standards. The course integrates hard research skills, transferable skills, and applied research practice, preparing students to conduct impactful studies and solve real-world problems.

Students engage in individual dissertation work and a team-based Community Project, applying research to real-life challenges. 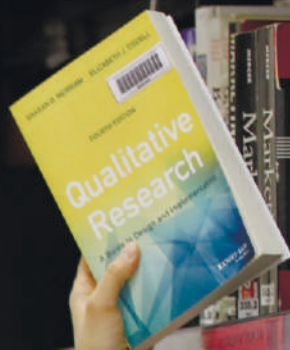

The Postgraduate Certificate in Research Methods for Social Sciences (PGCertRMfSS) is a strategic programme within the WIUT Graduate School, designed to build a strong foundation for individuals aiming to pursue research-based careers or continue with a PhD in social sciences. 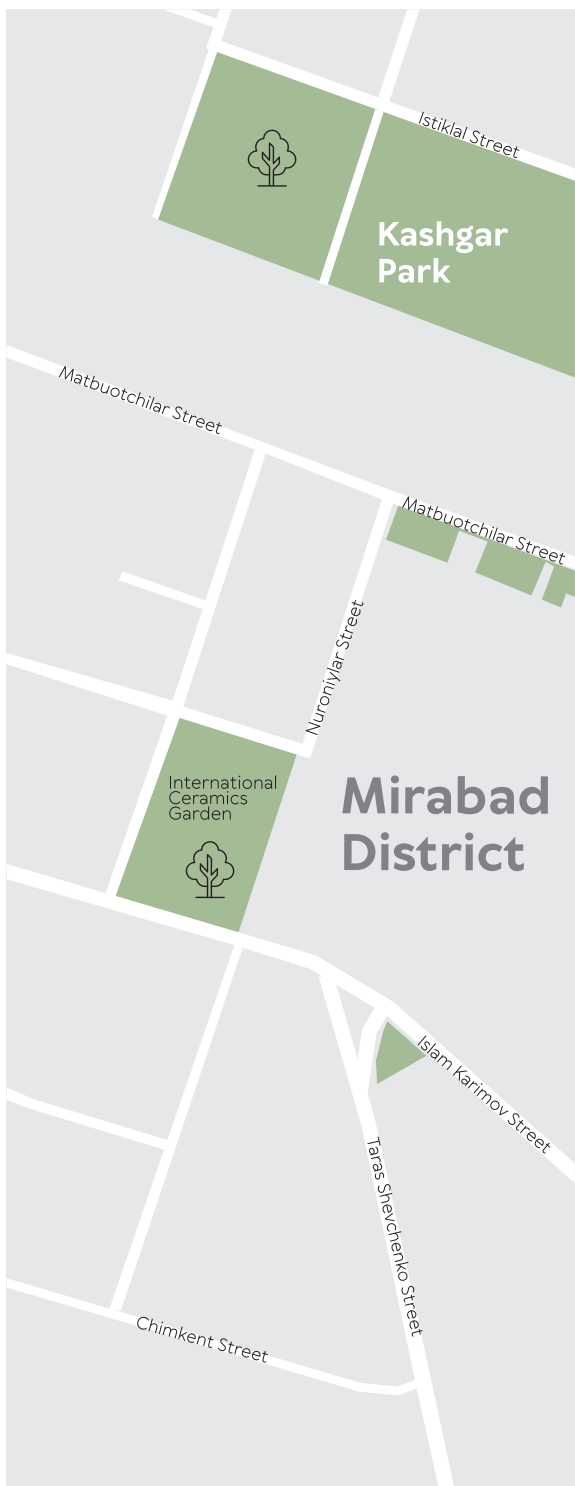

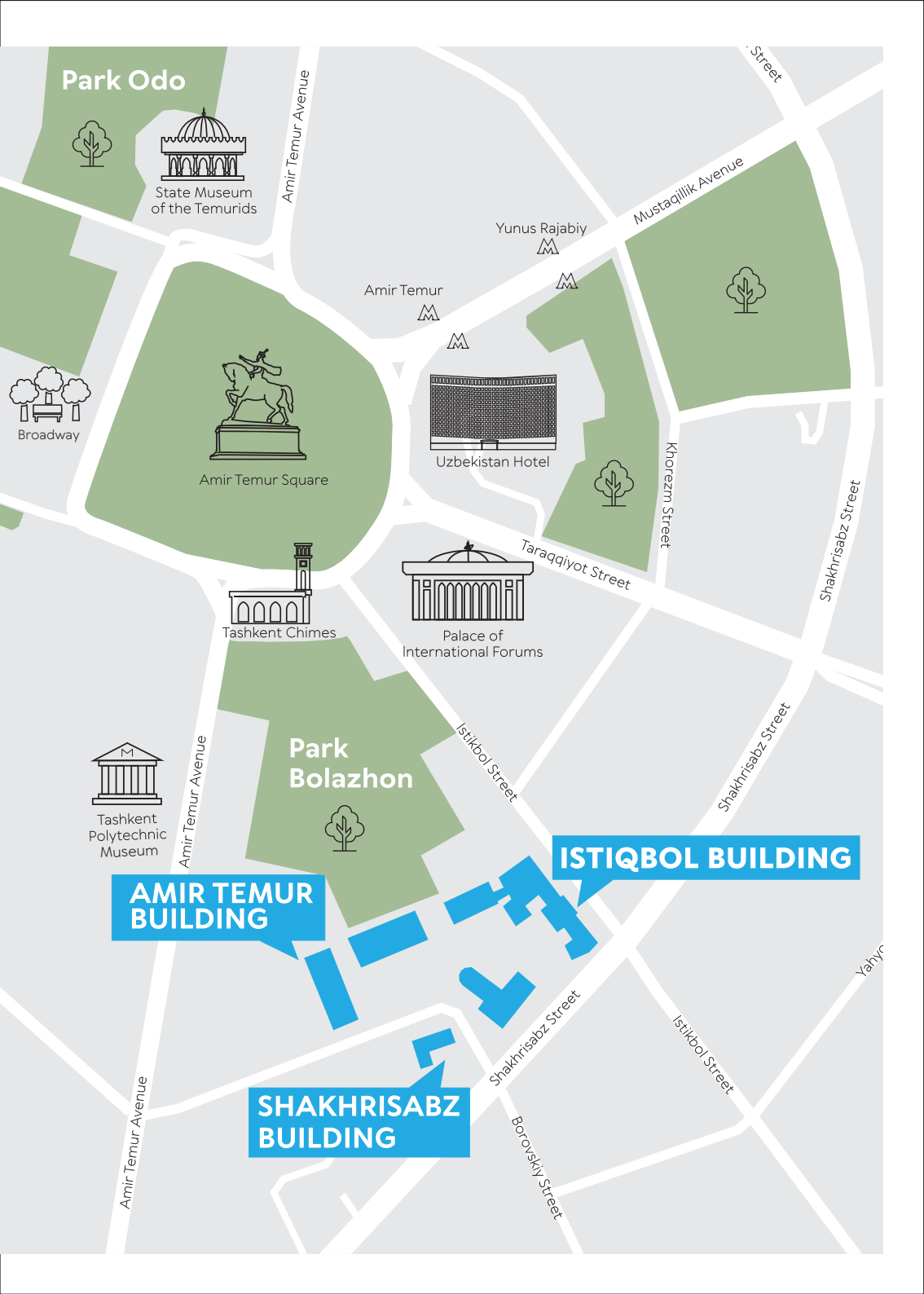

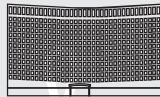

ISTIQBOL BUILDING

The Istiqbol Building building of Westminster International University in Tashkent at the intersection of Istikbol and Shakhrisabz streets is known to many Tashkent residents today - the old brick structure is recognizable and easy to remember. The building was built more than a 100 years ago, in 1912, according to the project of the famous Tashkent architect Georgy Svarichevsky. At that time, the building functioned as the 2nd women's gymnasium.

However, after the revolution in 1918, the building housed the newly established Turkestan People's University, later transformed into the Central Asian State University. Initially, the building was two-storied, but the third floor was added in the 30s of the 20th century. Since 1931, the Central Asian Planning and Economic Institute, named after Kuibyshev, operated in the building. Later, during the Soviet period, the building was given to the Aviation Technical College. The college was merged a century later with the newly formed Tashkent Aviation Institute.

In 2002, the building was given to the Westminster University, established by a special Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated January 16, 2002, № 22 "On the organization of the Westminster International University in Tashkent".

AMIR TEMUR BUILDING

The Amir Temur Building building was built in 2013, it features a modern design with enhanced spaces and improved functionality, fostering a better environment for learning and collaboration.

SHAKHRISABZ BUILDING

Completed in 2020, the Shakhrisabz Building building spans five floors and features innovative study rooms, social zones, large conference rooms, and hospitality training rooms, providing a modern environment for education and professional development.
