WHY MBA IN FINANCE?

The MBA in Finance is tailored for ambitious professionals and motivated graduates aiming to upgrade their skills and qualifications and advance their leadership capabilities.

The course emphasizes strategic thinking and decision-making skills. Additionally, the programme equips students with the

ability to approach real-world financial challenges using a creative mindset and robust managerial expertise.

This course prepares graduates for careers in financial analysis, project finance, risk management, corporate finance, consultancy, and other related roles.





HOW WILL I STUDY?

The course mainly follows a case-based learning approach, combining:

- Formal lectures to establish a strong theoretical foundation.
- Seminars and case studies that contextualise financial concepts.
- Practical workshops focused

on financial strategy and risk assessment.

- Student-led sessions and guest talks by industry experts to bridge academia and practice.
- An independent, selfmanaged MBA capstone project that integrates learned concepts with realworld analysis.



WHAT WILL I STUDY?

The MBA in Finance consists of core and optional modules. In order to be awarded a degree, students must study at least 180 credits. The course structure is validated by the University of Westminster (UK).

Core modules

- Strategic Leadership
- Data Analytics and Business Intelligence in Finance
- Accounting for Managers
- Applied Financial Management
- Entrepreneurial Finance and Venture Capital
- Applied Risk Management in Finance
- Applied Investment and Portfolio Management
- MBA Project

Optional modules

- Sustainable Finance and Banking
- Mergers, Acquisitions and Restructurings



WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS?

- Undergraduate degree with a minimum of a second lower class honours (2:2 or equivalent).
- Had their first or second degree (or equivalent) taught and assessed in English; or IELTS score of 6.5 with a minimum of 6.0 in the writing
- component or any other English language test recognised by the University of Westminster; or
- Achieved the required pass level on the WIUT Presessional Academic English Course for PG studies.
